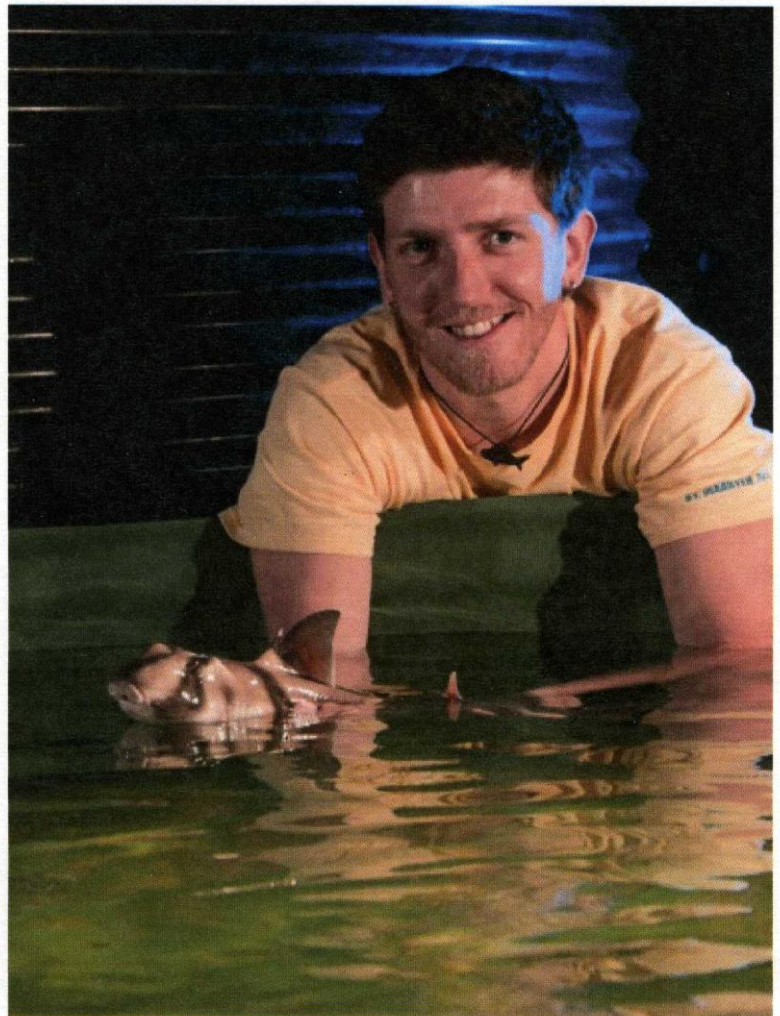
Taking a bite out of fiction

When sharks and humans interact

Shark populations are in trouble in Australia and around the world. Up to 73 million sharks are killed every year to satisfy an insatiable and unsustainable appetite for shark's fin soup.
